If Judgment is NOT satisfied within 50 days , the
Insurance Company is precluded from writing Bail Bonds
Statewide

If Judgment is Not Satisfied within 60 days, the OIR
Shall revoke the insurance company's COA

Insurance Company is precluded from writing ALL lines
of insurance statewide
